General Information on Ventspils

6th largest city in Latvia.

Main industries of the city: manufacturing, transport and logistics, tourism, services and construction.

2nd largest Latvian port and 3rd largest industrial city in Latvia.

Non-freezing, deep-water harbour, a Ro-Ro cargo centre of Latvia. Major gateway of Latvian imports/exports with Scandinavia.

Available area for industrial development ~500 ha.

SEZ - total number of companies in the special economic zone area 130, out of which 32 with special licence and 14 port terminals.

Regular Overseas Connections

Ventspils – a Ro-Ro transportation centre.

12 weekly calls to port of Nynashamn, Sweden (Stena Line, Ro-Pax).

Possibility to transship containers.

Trip duration – approx. 8.5 h.

Ventspils High Technology Park, building No. 5

Premises: 1396 m², land lot: 7085 m².

Rent of premises: 4.03 EUR/ m^2 /month.

Free height in the production area: 10 m (the building structure allows the installation of a beam crane with a lifting force of 10 t).

Permissible load on the floor: 5 t/m².

Available electric capacity: 1 MW.

City's central heating.

Special economic zone status is available.



Ventspils Business Support Centre is a branch of the Ventspils High Technology Park with the specific aim of attracting and supporting ICT and manufacturing companies:

- Co-working and office rental, reception and secretarial services, conference and meeting facilities;
- Business advice on fundraising, export promotion, business plan development, marketing and market research, digitalisation of industry, recruitment, accounting, networking, etc.;
- Implementation of various tech support projects.

Freeport – a Special Economic Zone


Ventspils Freeport is a special economic zone with tax benefits to the port terminals, logistics and industrial companies:

Corporate Income Tax and Real Estate Tax are reduced by 80% until the company compensates up to 40% (60% for small and 50% for medium-size companies) of the investments.

It means that during the compensation period:

- Corporate Income Tax rate is 0%;
- Tax on dividends is 4%;
- Real Estate Tax rate is 0.3%.

Example:



<u>Savings on dividend payout = 215 000 - 43 000 =</u> <u>172 000</u>

Total potential savings 40% - 60% of 10 mil.
